

Notes for Managers/Coaches/Team Representatives & Parents.

The committee welcomes you all and thanks those that have agreed to help with the running of your team.

The Coaches role: you guessed it is to coach. To enable coaches to have a better understanding of the rules and training routines, there will be compulsory training courses for all coaches. There will be no cost to individuals. You may also be asked to attend a committee meeting when required. **You must wear your coaches vest on game day.**

The Managers roles entails making sure everyone in your team is aware of training times, where and at what time your next game is played. Also on game day to make contact with the other team's manager and check players Id, remember no Id no game. Organise a roster system for the washing of team shirts. These once cleaned must be returned to the manager at next training session.

The Marshall must be a responsible adult. Your role is to control the behaviour of spectators and ensure they stay at least 1 metre away from side lines. The safety of the referee is paramount whether being an official black and white referee or a parent who has volunteered. No abuse of the referee will be tolerated. There is no smoking or drinking of alcohol at Oakville oval, any persons must be asked to refrain. There will be a committee member available to assist you if needed. **You must wear your marshalls vest.**

Parents you must attend the training sessions and help out if asked by the coaches. You must be present to keep an eye on your child; the coaches role is to coach. If your child is injured or needs to go to the toilets you must be present to attend to these matters. On game day you must be at the game 30 minutes prior to commencement. There may be nets to be put out, this is not the coaches or manages role, their roles are to prepare the team for play. All parents and teams will be given a roster to help out in the canteen and bbq, this will strictly be enforced. Any team which does not participate in their rostered time will be asked to appear before the committee to show cause why that team should not receive a penalty. Penalties range from team suspension to team deregistration. The committee decision shall be final.

Team Representative – A person out of each team must be chosen to represent that team at our monthly committee meetings. These are held on the 2nd Monday of each month at the Pitt Town Sports Club commencing at 7pm. This is an important role as it gives the committee feed back on your team; any suggestions from your team and allows you to take back to your team matters that the committee may wish to be passed on. Failure to attend and miss 2 consecutive meetings could involve a penalty imposed on your team. These penalties range from team suspension to team deregistration. The committee decision shall be final.

Most importantly we all have a common cause; we want our children to have fun. Unfortunately it doesn't just happen we need each and every one of you to help out with the running of Your Club.
